- mouthwash (alcohol free)
- soap
- deodorant
- hand or body lotion
- shampoo and conditioner
- tissues (full-size boxes)
- disposable razors
- shaving cream
- women's hygiene products
- disposable diapers and baby wipes
- Advil, Tylenol and cold medicines
- underwear and socks
- brush and comb
